Individual Consultant Selection in support of the management and the monitoring of the "Attahadi High School Model" component of the "Secondary Education" project

On November 30, 2015, the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco concluded a second cooperation program (Compact II) with the United States Government, represented by the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), with the objective to improve the quality of human capital and land productivity.

The budget allocated by MCC to Compact II, which came into effect on June 30, 2017, amounts to 450 million dollars, to which is added a contribution of the Moroccan Government of a value equivalent to at least 15% of the American contribution. The global budget will finance, over a period of five years, two projects, namely "Education and Training for Employability" and "Land Productivity", the implementation of which has been entrusted to the Millennium Challenge Account - Morocco (Agence MCA-Morocco).

By way of this specific procurement notice, Agence MCA-Morocco requests proposals to procure the services of an Individual Consultant Selection in support of the management and the monitoring of the "Attahadi High School Model" component of the "Secondary Education" project.

More details of these consultant services are provided in the Terms of Reference.

Please note that this is an English translation of a notice originally drafted in French. Please note that all communication and solicitation documents related to this notice will be in French.

The selected Consultant will be awarded a contract of 26 (twenty-six) months from the date of notification of the start service order without exceeding the Compact end date (June 30,2022). The level of effort breaks down as follows:

- A basic period of 9 months;
- A first optional period of 8 months;
- A second optional period of 8 months.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Procurement Method for Individual Consultant Services (ICS).
