## Specific Procurement Notice DP/QCBS/MCA-M/M&E-08/Compact-PP-10

### Data Collection for the evaluation of the activity "Development of Vocational Training and Employment" in Morocco, divided into two lots: Lot 1: "the collection of quantitative data" Lot 2: "the collection of qualitative data"

On November 30, 2015, the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco concluded a second cooperation program (Compact II) with the United States Government, represented by the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), with the objective to improve the quality of human capital and land productivity.

The budget allocated by MCC to Compact II, which came into effect on June 30, 2017, amounts to 450 million dollars, to which is added a contribution of the Moroccan Government of a value equivalent to at least 15% of the American contribution. The global budget will finance, over a period of five years, two projects, namely "Education and Training for Employability" and "Land Productivity", the implementation of which has been entrusted to the Millennium Challenge Account - Morocco (Agence MCA-Morocco).

By way of this Specific Procurement Notice, Agence MCA-Morocco requests proposals for consultant services "Data Collection for the evaluation of the activity "Development of Vocational Training and Employment" in Morocco", divided into two lots:

Lot 1: "the collection of quantitative data"

#### Lot 2: "the collection of qualitative data

More details of these consultant services are provided in the Terms of Reference.

Agence MCA-Morocco invites proposals from legally constituted consulting firms to provide the services.

The interested consultants may bid for one or two lots.

# The MCA-Morocco will award a contract for base period, for each lot, without exceeding the Compact End Date of June 30, 2022, of a duration of:

- 13 months maximum for <u>lot 1</u>;
- 20 months maximum for lot 2;

A firm will be selected in accordance under the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in the RFP in accordance with "MCC Program Procurement Guidelines" which are provided on the MCC website (<u>www.mcc.gov/ppg</u>).
