The Millennium Challenge Account-Morocco has received financing from the Millennium Challenge Corporation toward the cost of the "Education and Training for Employability and Land Employability projects", and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the "Acquisition of specific school equipment (for school clubs) for the beneficiaries'schools as part of "Attahadi Model Component" divided into three lots:

- Lot 1: Acquisition of equipment for audiovisual school clubs (theater-cinema-school radio)
- Lot 2: Acquisition of equipment for language teaching and communication tools (language lab-miscellaneous package)
- Lot 3: Acquisition of equipment for artistic and environment clubs (Music education-plastic art-environment)

The interested consultants may bid for one or more lots.

MCC's funding is appropriated by the U.S. Congress and obligated to the compact up-front, with no incremental or partial funding. So, when a contract is signed with an MCA Entity, money is already available to the MCA Entity and, for most contracts, invoices are paid directly to Suppliers by the

US Treasury. MCA-Morocco now invites bids from eligible bidders for the acquisition of specific school equipment.

Bidding will be conducted through the Competitive Bidding ("CB") procedures as specified in the MCC Program Procurement Guidelines (PPG), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the PPG.

All Bids must be accompanied by a bid(s) security (ies), original version, with the amount(s) as follows:

- Lot 1: 150 000 Moroccan Dirhams (MAD) or its equivalent in Dollar US (USD);
- Lot 2: 70 000 Moroccan Dirhams (MAD) or its equivalent in Dollar US (USD);
- Lot 3: 100 000 Moroccan Dirhams (MAD) or its equivalent in Dollar US (USD);

in a closed envelope and must be delivered to the address below no later than 1 March 2021 at 3 p.m (Rabat time).
