Selection of an Individual Consultant in charge of supporting the analysis of public expenditure on upkeep and maintenance of the Department of National Education at central level

The Government of the Kingdom of Morocco concluded, on November 30, 2015, a second cooperation program (Compact II) with the government of the United States of America, represented by Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), with the aim of enhance the quality of human capital and improve land productivity.

The budget allocated by MCC to this cooperation program amounts to 450 million dollars, to which is added a contribution of the Moroccan government of at least 15%. The total amount is intended to finance two projects namely "Education and training for employability" and "Productivity of land" and whose implementation is spread over 5 years from June 30, 2017.

By way of this specific procurement notice, MCA-Morocco Agency requests proposals from Individual Consultant to be in charge of supporting the analysis of public expenditure on upkeep and maintenance of the Department of National Education at central level.

Individual consultants will be selected in accordance with MCC's procurement guidelines for individual consultants using the "Individual Consultant (IC)" procedure. This evaluation procedure is based on the qualification of the consultant and whose guidelines are available on the MCC website www.mcc.gov/resources/doc/program-procurement-guidelines

The selected Consultant will be awarded a contract for a period of 3 months.
