Specific Procurement Notice N° ICS/MCA-M/PP-61/Compact

Pool of Experts for the evaluation of proposals / tenders as part of the procurement process (Framework Contracts)

On November 30, 2015, the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco concluded a second cooperation program (Compact II) with the Government of the United States of America, represented by the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), aiming to improve the quality of human capital and land productivity.

The budget allocated by MCC to Compact II, which came into effect on June 30th, 2017, amounts to 450 million dollars, to which is added a contribution of the Moroccan Government of a value equivalent to at least 15% of the American contribution. The global budget will finance, over a period of five years, two projects, namely "Education and Training for Employability" and "Land Productivity", the implementation of which has been entrusted to the Millennium Challenge Account - Morocco (Agence MCA-Morocco).

By way of this specific procurement notice, Agence MCA-Morocco requests proposals to procure a **Pool of Experts for the evaluation of proposals / tenders as part of the procurement process**.

The selected Consultants will each be awarded a framework contract with an overall duration not exceeding the date of the end of the Compact II June 30th, 2022.

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the Procurement Method for Individual Consultant Services (ICS).
